

Zoom Feature of Toolkit

Don't forget that you can always change the level of magnification in Toolkit. Simply click on the zoom icon in the overhead toolbar [the magnifying glass is next to it.] You'll get a dialog box like the one shown. Select the zoom percent you want and then click on OK. Your viewing screen will then be changed to the percent zoom you have selected.
